The McKenzie Noelle Wilson Foundation Provides Local Students an Extraordinary Opportunity To Be Part of THE PLAYERS Championship

Following a lunch provided by The McKenzie Noelle Wilson Foundation, students will enjoy games and activities inside the newly expanded Kid Zone, which was renamed The McKenzie Noelle Wilson Foundation Kid Zone this year.

"Many of these students haven't had a lot of exposure to golf, and the chance to visit THE PLAYERS Stadium Course at TPC is really special. By coming to the tournament and participating in the activities we have planned, these young people will have the opportunity to visit one of the highest caliber courses in the country while learning more about values such as respect and perseverance through the game of golf."

The Kid Zone at THE PLAYERS Championship, open May 8-12, has undergone major enhancements for this year's tournament. Presented in partnership by PGA TOUR and The McKenzie Noelle Wilson Foundation, the Kid Zone is a unique venue for children and families that features a putt-putt golf course, arts and crafts, face-painting, an inflatable obstacle course, an ultimate "GameTruck" and a misting tent to cool down.
